Day 1: Arrive Delhi

Day 2: Delhi

Delhi with its Old and New parts — each with its specific charm and glory — makes a very interesting city for its sustenance to medieval and modern cultures at the same time and space. Today, you will explore the capital of India in a full-day guided tour — visiting Jama Mosque, Red Fort, Gandhi's cremation site, Humayun's Tomb and Qutab Minar. You will also enjoy a rikshaw ride in Old Delhi and will drive past the colonial Delhi....

Day 3: Delhi Khajuraho

This morning you will be taken to the airport to catch your flight to Khajuraho — the land where Kamasutra was put in sculpture. Upon arrival in Khajuraho you will be received and taken to your hotel. In the afternoon, you will tour Western Group of Temples before returning to the hotel....

Day 4: Khajuraho

The first half of the day will be spent in exploring the Eastern Group of Temples. The afternoon may be spent in leisure or you may explore the little town on your own...

Day 5: Khajuraho – Orchha – Agra

Your day starts when you will be driven to Jhansi rail station to catch train for Agra. En route to Jhansi you will visit sleepy medieval town of Orchha. You will arrive in Agra in the evening and retire for the day....

Day 6: Agra

Today you will do sightseeing tour of Agra. In the first half you will visit Tomb of Itimad-ud-daulah and the Agra Fort. Later in the evening you will be taken on a tonga (horse-carriage) to visit the Taj Mahal at sunset (Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays).

Day 7: Agra – Samode

After a leisurely morning you will be driven to Samode which is just outside Jaipur. En route visit Fatehpur Sikri, a perfectly preserved Mughal city built at the height of the empire's splendor. You will arrive at the small village of Samode, nestled among rugged hills, in the afternoon. Once a noble state, the Samode Palace is decorated in Shekhawati style with a wealth of frescoes, many of them depicting religious subjects.

Day 8: Samode – Jaipur – Samode

The day will be spent in an excursion to Jaipur. In the morning, you visit the Amber Fort — one of the most fascinating of Indian forts. You will reach the fort majestically atop an elephant; once inside the fort, you visit the Palace of Mirrors, Hall of Public Audience and the beautifully manicured gardens. Afternoon you will spend exploring the City Palace, the Hawa Mahal (the Palace of Winds) and the Jantar Mantar (astrological observatory).

Day 9: Samode – Deogarh

Today, you will be driven to the town of Deogarh. You will arrive at Deogarh in the noon and check into Deogarh Mahal. Restored and run by the erstwhile ruling family the area, Deogarh Mahal is one of the best-maintained and run palace hotel. The palace hotel also has extremely impressive collection of old miniature paintings — in fact, the Deogarh School of Painting was one of the most important school of Indian miniature paintings.

Day 10: Deogarh – Ranakpur – Deogarh

This morning you will make a short excursion to Ranakpur Temples — the largest and most beautifully preserved Jain Temples in India. In the evening you will be taken to the Deogarh cave temples which will be followed by a train ride in the neighbouring areas. This will be your chance to closely see Rajasthani villages and their unique customs. The afternoon may be spent in the hotel or you may walk down to the nearby lake, visited by a large number of migratory birds from November to February.

Day 11: Deogarh – Kumbhalgarh – Udaipur

Today, en route your journey to Udaipur, you visit the Kumbhalgarh Fort. If Ranakpur is beauty and grace, Kumbhalgarh is all about power. Perhaps the most majestic of all forts in India, Kumbhalgarh boasts of the second largest wall in the world. You will arrive in

Udaipur in the afternoon and will be at leisure.

Overnight: Udaipur

Day 12: Udaipur

The day begins with a visit to the City Palace, which is largest in Rajasthan. You will also see lovely medieval Jagdish Temple and Sahelion-Ki-Bari or the "Gardens of the Maids of Honour". The day will end with a relaxing boat ride on Lake Pichola. From the lake you will get unmatched views of the gardens surrounding the fascinating Lake Palace Hotel and the two islands in the lake.

Day 13: Udaipur – Mumbai – Goa

This morning you will be taken to Udaipur airport to catch your flight to Bombay. Upon arrival in Bombay you will be assisted to connect to your onward flight to Goa. In Goa you will be received by our representative and escorted to your hotel where the rest of the day may be spent in leisure....
